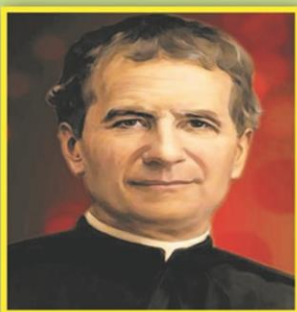

St. Mary's Higher Secondary School is the upgraded section of St. Mary's English High School, an educational institution established and administered by the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians (FMA), popularly known as Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco. The aim of the Higher Secondary section is to introduce young women to higher education and promote their holistic development.

VISION

We envisage our pupils to become intellectually enlightened, morally upright, spiritually oriented, emotionally balanced, socially committed, patriotic, eco-friendly and accomplished – in a word integrally developed young women who will be agents of social transformation in the pluri-cultural, multi-religious context of our nation.

MISSION

St. Mary's Higher Secondary School is committed to making integral formation accessible to young women of diverse backgrounds. Our mission is to provide a student-centered learning environment within a family atmosphere that embodies the Salesian philosophy of reason, religion, and loving kindness as taught by St. John Bosco and St. Mary Mazzarello. We challenge our students to develop their potential and to dedicate themselves to academic excellence, faith, leadership and service as they take their place in our rapidly changing and pluralistic society.

OUR EDUCATIONAL APPROACH

The system of education followed in the Schools run by the Salesian Sisters is the Preventive System. It is the key that gives access to the heart of every young person. There are very few people who rebel in the face of genuine goodness. One gets discipline by using a blend of kindness and firmness, and by never asking what is beyond the strength of the child. Loving kindness is order to have a true educational value must be based on a healthy equilibrium, which while surrounding the child with genuine love, avoids every form of false affection, and renders the teacher-pupil relationship, a shared search for true values. Don Bosco's philosophy of education is summarized in this principle, which explains, justifies and actuates it : "Education is a matter of the heart."

The sisters, Teachers, Parents and Students constitute an integral unit known as the Educating Community whose primary aim is to form the young to become builders of an honest society, women of upright thinking and acting, commitment and competence.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians (FMA), popularly known as the Salesian Sister is an International organization founded in Italy in the year 1872 by St. John Bosco (Don Bosco), the great modern educator, in collaboration with St. Mary Domenica Mazzarello who is the Co-foundress of the Institute. Today the Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco, numbering about 15,000, continue the apostolate of Integral Education of the young in the spirit of their founders through 1600 educational institutions spread over 90 countries of the world.

St. Mary's Higher Secondary School, Guwahati (Established in 1924), is one such institution. It is an English Medium School established by the Salesian Sisters of Guwahati Province which has its Provincial Head Quarters at Guwahati – Assam. It is owned and managed by them and it is a registered body under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, No. RS/KAM/240/K/74 of 2000-2001.

The primary aim of St. Mary's Higher Secondary School, Guwahati is to impart integral formation (Physical, Intellectual, Moral, Social and Spiritual) to all who are admitted to this institution. It's our endeavour to form the students into good and honest citizens, worthy of God and our nation, capable of reaching out the less fortunate brothers and sisters and contributing to the building up of a society based on peace, justice and brotherhood / sisterhood.

The course of instruction comprises of all the branches of education prescribed by the Secondary Education Board of Assam and prepares the students for the H.S.L.C. and H.S.S.L.C. Examination conducted by the Board / Council.

SUBJECT OFFERED

SCIENCE : English, Alt English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Computer Science, Environmental Science.

ARTS : English, Alt English, Political Science, Economics, Education, Computer Science, Psychology, Sociology, Environmental Science.

COMMERCE: English, Alt English, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Commercial Mathematics and Statistic, Banking, Environmental Science.

All Students must be present in the school by 7.30 am. They should attend the Morning Assembly / Prayer. No student is allowed to remain in the school premises after class hours.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND GUIDELINES FOR BEHAVIOUR CLASS DECORUM :

A student's behaviour should be such as to bring honour to herself, her family and to the school. Genuine love and respect towards teachers are important values in our Indian tradition of teacher - student relationship. The school aims at inculcating these values in the students. Seminars and personality/career guidance Programmes are arranged with this aim in view. Students are expected to attend them compulsorily and profit from these experiences.

Moral Science class, Meditation, class prayers and reflections will be regularly conducted to develop moral and spiritual values.

FACILITIES

SCIENCE LABORATORIES

- a) The school is equipped with spacious and well furnished labs with excellent to cater to the growing demands of the present educational system. There are laboratories to cater to different subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
- b) Students are expected to avail the lab opportunities provided to them to the optimum.
- c) They have to take utmost care of the equipments during any experimental operations. Any lapse on their part while handling lab equipment will entail a fine or even replacement of the same by them.
- d) Students should be aware that the lab exists to develop their scientific aptitudes, hence it is mandatory to maintain absolute silence while the sessions are in progress.



SCHOOL LIBRARY

- a) The School Library helps the students to enrich their knowledge. Students are requested to make maximum profit out of it.
- b) The working hours of the library will be the same as that of the school.
- c) Reference book is meant for use only inside the library.
- d) In the event of a student scribbling or tearing pages from the library books she will have to pay double the cost of the book and not just the actual cost.



UNIFORM / DRESS CODE

Personal appearance helps to develop self confidence and promote an environment of mutual respect, uniformity and dignity. Therefore all students will wear the uniform prescribed for the Higher Secondary Section of the school. (Grey trousers, white top and Tie, Grey Blazers, Black Shoes). Ornaments and other personal decorative articles are strictly prohibited. Students should plait their hair neatly and tie with black rubber band or ribbon.

SMART CLASS

Smart Class is a highly interactive computer based aid which makes lessons come alive. Through the Smart class program teachers use digital resources such as Animation Clips, Videos, Pictures, Diagrams, Maps, Graphs, Working models, Computer based simulations etc. from the vast repository, while teaching the chosen topic in the classroom enabling students to acquire a faster and a better understanding of the concepts taught. Through the internet teachers connect to information resources far beyond the physical confines of the classroom and bring the virtual world within the walls of the classroom thus exponentially increasing the knowledge base for practical use in teaching and learning.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES- WINDOWS OF OPPORTUNITY

It is opportunities galore for the students of St. Mary's School to grow up into multi-faceted personalities. The concept of testing the multiple intelligence of the child makes every student feel like a winner.
